Visit a Gaza community directly affected by the 7th of October massacre • Provide & serve lunch for local security members or soldiers • Visit Hostage Square in Tel Aviv • Return to Jerusalem.

Temple Mount & Western Wall visit • Hospital Visit – soldiers/civilians **and/or** visit a displaced community at one of the hotels. Spend time with them (stories with the children, English lesson) • After dinner participate in a meeting – guest speaker (ZAKA or another organization).
