Centered on the theme *“The Lord Roars from Zion.”* (Joel 3:16), the USA Feast Tour will unite representatives from all 50 states in worship, prayer, and visible solidarity with Israel. As America marks its 250th anniversary, this gathering becomes even more significant—a national offering of faith, gratitude, and biblical alignment in the City of the Great King.

Participants will join thousands of Christians from around the world for the vibrant Feast of Tabernacles celebration—marked by powerful worship, biblical teaching, global communion, and joyful expressions of the nations. It is a moving witness of unity and faith in Jerusalem.

The tour also includes time in the land of the Bible—walking ancient streets, visiting key biblical sites, and sharing moments of prayer, reflection, and fellowship. As the Lord roars from Zion, America will be present, answering the call and representing every state at this prophetic gathering.



The Feast of Tabernacles

A Biblical Celebration, a Global Gathering

The Feast of Tabernacles—Sukkot—is one of the biblical festivals appointed by the Lord (Leviticus 23), a joyful time of thanksgiving, worship, and dwelling in God's presence. It also carries prophetic significance, pointing to the day when all nations will come to Jerusalem to worship the King (Zechariah 14:16). For Christians, the Feast is a powerful opportunity to align with God's purposes and stand in visible solidarity with Israel and the Jewish people.

Since 1980, the International Christian Embassy Jerusalem (ICEJ) has hosted the modern Christian celebration of the Feast. What began as an expression of comfort and support for Israel has grown into the largest annual Christian gathering in the nation, drawing thousands of believers from around the world.

Through vibrant worship, biblical teaching, and the joyful Jerusalem March, the Feast offers a life-changing pilgrimage experience and a lasting witness of Christian love for Israel.

Tour Itinerary

SEPTEMBER 23-24

Depart USA → Arrive in Israel

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the United States and arrive in the land of the Bible. After a warm welcome, the journey starts with fellowship, orientation, and preparation for the days ahead as you settle into Israel and prepare for the Feast experience.

SEPTEMBER 24

The Judean Desert & Dead Sea

Travel to the Dead Sea—the lowest place on earth—for a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to float in its mineral-rich waters. In the surrounding Judean wilderness, gather for worship, teaching, and spiritual reflection.

SEPTEMBER 25

Desert Worship & Feast Opening Celebration

Experience the beauty of the desert with times of fellowship and solidarity before joining the opening Feast celebration near Qumran—where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered.

SEPTEMBER 26

Masada, Ein Gedi & Jerusalem

Ascend Masada by cable car and reflect on faith and perseverance atop this ancient fortress. Continue to the oasis of Ein Gedi, where King David once hid from King Saul for worship before a memorable desert hospitality experience. Later, journey up to Jerusalem for evening Feast celebrations.

SEPTEMBER 27

Mount of Olives & Old City Jerusalem

Stand on the Mount of Olives overlooking the Holy City, pray in the Garden of Gethsemane, and walk the Via Dolorosa. Visit the Pools of Bethesda and conclude with communion at the Garden Tomb.

SEPTEMBER 28

Feast Celebration & Jerusalem March

Participate in Feast gatherings and fellowship before joining the Jerusalem March—where believers from the nations publicly demonstrate their love for Israel. Evening celebrations continue with vibrant worship.

SEPTEMBER 29

City of David & Temple Foundations

Explore Jerusalem's ancient foundations—descending into the City of David, walking through Hezekiah's Tunnel, and standing on the Southern Steps where pilgrims once entered the temple.

Conclude with prayer at the Western Wall and its underground tunnels.

SEPTEMBER 30

Jordan Valley → Galilee

Depart Jerusalem and travel north through the Jordan Valley. Visit the impressive ruins of Beit She'an and continue to the baptismal waters of the Jordan River before arriving in the Galilee region.

OCTOBER 1

Sea of Galilee Ministry Sites

Worship on the Mount of Beatitudes, sail across the Sea of Galilee, and visit Capernaum—Jesus' ministry base. Explore Magdala and the Primacy of Peter.

OCTOBER 2

Northern Israel & Golan Heights

Journey to Tel Dan, connected to the stories of Abraham and ancient Israel. Stand on the Golan Heights overlooking modern borders, gaining perspective on both biblical and current events in the region.

OCTOBER 3

Mount Carmel & Caesarea → Departure

Visit Mount Carmel, where Elijah called the nation back to God, and Caesarea Maritima, where the gospel first launched to the Gentile world. Celebrate your journey with a farewell dinner before departing for the airport.

OCTOBER 4

Return Home

Arrive back in the United States carrying lifelong memories, deeper faith, and a renewed connection to Israel and God's Word.

YOUR TOUR HOST IN ISRAEL

The International Christian Embassy Jerusalem (ICEJ) was established in 1980 as a tangible expression of Christian love and solidarity with Israel when many nations withdrew their embassies from Jerusalem. In that same year, ICEJ began hosting the modern Christian celebration of the Feast of Tabernacles—gathering believers in Jerusalem during God’s appointed time. Rooted in the prophetic vision of Scripture that the nations will one day come to worship the King in Jerusalem, the Feast carries profound spiritual significance for Christians today. What began as a bold act of comfort has grown into the largest annual Christian gathering in Israel, drawing thousands from around the world. By participating, you step into a living expression of biblical prophecy and a decades-long legacy of standing with Israel in Jerusalem.

Terms & Conditions

DEPOSIT: A US \$500 deposit is required for your reservation/application to be considered complete. Please be aware there are a limited number of spaces available for this tour, and your completed application with deposit secures your space.

TOUR PRICE (September 23 – October 4, 2026): All prices are per person based on two people sharing a room with a private bath. Single rooms are subject to availability with an additional charge. All tour prices shown are subject to a minimum of 30 people per bus traveling together. If we have fewer than the required minimum participants, we reserve the right to adjust the price. Once our reserved airline and hotel space is filled, we cannot guarantee the published tour price. If your tour itinerary includes a hotel check-in on a Shabbat or Shabbat type holiday your room occupancy may occur later than normal.

FOREIGN CURRENCY EXCHANGE: Some of your tour costs may be based on foreign currency exchange rates and in the event of significant fluctuations could affect the final pricing.

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FOR TOUR (September 23 – October 4, 2026): The tour is based on a round-trip airfare from Los Angeles, CA (LAX) or New York City (JFK). Taxes and airline fuel surcharges will be included in your price. Occasionally airlines will charge extra for fuel surcharges. If that happens we will advise you and if the change is substantial add the increase to the price of the tour. Our group airline price is not guaranteed until the day we ticket.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: A US \$500 deposit is needed to complete your reservation/application. Both airline seats and hotel space are limited as Israel is one of the number one destinations for travel in the world. Your completed application and deposit secures your place on the trip. Additional US \$1,500 is due on or before June 1, 2026 to ICEJ-USA. Final payment is due on or before August 1, 2026 to ICEJ-USA. You may at any time pay the full amount of your trip prior to scheduled date.

DEVIATIONS: Airline tickets are group priced eleven months prior to departure. ANY group airline ticket change will incur a minimum deviation fee of US \$150 plus or minus the cost of the ticketing change.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations received are subject to any cancellation requirements of the airlines plus costs paid by tour operator which cannot be recovered from hotels and foreign agencies. **Cancellation notice must be received by the ICEJ in writing.**

From deposit until June 1, 2026 a US \$250 cancellation penalty

From Jun 2, 2026 to Aug 1, 2026 a US \$500 cancellation penalty

After August 1, 2026 – no refunds unless special circumstances or arrangements have been made

REGISTRATION: To register, please complete the tour application at www.icejusa.org/feast-tour and then activate your online WeTravel.com account, upload a copy of the photo page of your passport and submit the initial \$500 deposit by credit card or by check payable to ICEJ-USA Tours, PO Box 332974, Murfreesboro, TN 37133. All additional payments may be made online through your WeTravel.com account, by phone, or by mail to: ICEJ-USA Tours, PO Box 332974, Murfreesboro, TN 37133. Most major credit cards are accepted. Upon receipt of your deposit and completed application, additional information will be sent to you via email.

PASSPORTS: A copy of your passport will be required with your application and deposit. If you do not have a valid passport, please indicate on your application that you are in the process of obtaining one. By Israeli law, your passport must be valid until 6 months after the day you return from Israel (April 20, 2027). If your passport is not valid for more than 6 months from the date you return you will not be allowed to board the aircraft.

TRAVEL VISA: Israel has implemented a new online electronic travel visa for entry into Israel. You **MUST** fill out this form and receive approval to enter Israel. Once filled out, you should receive formal "approval" within a few minutes of finalizing the form. <https://israel-entry.piba.gov.il/apply-for-an-eta-il-1/>

SIGHTSEEING: This is subject to local conditions at the time of the tour. Adjustments in the program may be made as the tour leader deems necessary for the safety and benefit of the group.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: There may be limitations and restrictions imposed by the travel suppliers (air carrier, tour operator, etc.). Activities on tour require you to be in good health and able to climb stairs and ascending grades without assistance, walk at a modest pace for 3+ miles per day on uneven terrain, and, be able to transport your own luggage when necessary. In order to participate in all aspects of the tour and travel at the pace of the group, we recommend a walking/exercise routine before the trip to build up stamina if needed.

TIPS: Tips and gratuities of \$220.00 per person for the bus drivers, Israeli guides, hotel staff, restaurants and selected sites have NOT been included in the pricing.

TRAVEL MEDICAL INSURANCE: Medical Travel Insurance coverage is required for the duration of your time in Israel. Please confirm that your current medical insurance provides coverage for medical expenses on a reimbursement basis while in Israel. If your current medical insurance does not provide coverage while in Israel, International Travel Medical Insurance is very reasonable further information is provided on the registration form. Proof of your Travel Medical Insurance can be mailed or emailed to the ICEJ Tours office.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: To protect your travel investment and cover unforeseen expenses, we suggest you consider the purchase of a Comprehensive Travel insurance policy that includes coverage, for cancellation, interruption, disruption, unexpected emergencies, and Acts of God such as weather conditions. In order to receive the maximum coverage most Travel Insurance companies require the policy be secured within 10-30 days of your initial deposit for the trip.

VACCINATION & TESTING REQUIREMENTS: As of May 20, 2022 there are no requirements for COVID-19 or other vaccinations and no COVID testing is required to enter Israel. This is subject to change. Should these requirements change, we will notify you immediately and take steps to ensure the best outcome for the entire group.

RESPONSIBILITIES: SAR-EL Tours and the ICEJ USA act only in the capacity of agent for the passengers in all matters pertaining to hotel accommodations, sight-seeing, tour, and transportation, by air, motor-coach, or other means and, as such, hold themselves free of responsibility for any damage(s) from any cause(s) whatsoever. The tour operators and ICEJ USA will not be responsible for any damage, expense or inconvenience caused by late flight departures, mechanical failures, global pandemics, war, government actions, or any change of schedules including, but not limited to altered tour dates due to border closures, or other travel conditions which could result in a change of tour dates. The tour operators and ICEJ USA will furthermore not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to baggage or any article belonging to any passenger. The right is also reserved to decline or accept or retain any person traveling under our auspices. The airline carriers concerned are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board their plane or conveyance. The passenger contract used by the carriers concerned, when issued, will constitute the sole contract between carriers and the purchasers of this tour or its passengers.
