Never has the ministry of the International Christian Embassy Jerusalem been needed like it was in 2025 and will continue to be for the foreseeable future.

In this report you will find that the ICEJ's capacity expanded through these challenges and the ministry had the greatest impact ever in both Israel and the United States. The 2025 Feast of Tabernacles was the largest solidarity event for Israel since the war began. The ICEJ's global prayer initiative had mobilized an army of Christians into 183 countries to pray for Israel. The USA Branch of the ICEJ reached more people with its biblical message of support for Israel than ever before.

We ended the year grateful for all we had been able to accomplish but aware that a new year would bring many more opportunities to serve the people of Israel and connect them with the global church. Your financial support, prayers, and encouragement made all of this possible. Thank you for your continued partnership.

ICEJ USA's ministry and mission are fueled by prayer.

Last year was no exception as we mobilized believers across America to stand with Israel at a critical moment in history. Throughout the year, ICEJ USA led approximately **350 hours of prayer** and participated in an additional **750 hours of prayer led by our ICEJ colleagues at the Jerusalem headquarters**, joining a global network of intercessors standing in the gap for Israel and the nations.

In the fall, ICEJ USA prayer leaders participated in a multistate prayer tour spanning Alaska to Virginia, joining intercessors across the country in praying for their states and for Israel. This momentum culminated with *Communion America* on the National Mall in Washington, D.C.

During the Feast of Tabernacles, we hosted the **Ascend Prayer Tour to Israel**, uniting 19 women from across the United States in an appointed time of worship, intercession, and prophetic declaration. During the tour, answered prayer unfolded in real time with the release of the remaining living hostages from Gaza.

You Helped Comfort, Restore, and Rebuild

In 2025, ICEJ AID stood on the frontlines in Israel—responding to crisis, restoring dignity, and investing in Israel's future. Through our donors' faithful partnership, tangible expressions of comfort reached the Jewish people at every stage of need.

From war-torn communities to Holocaust Survivors, from new immigrants stepping onto Israeli soil to vulnerable families seeking stability, your generosity delivered lifesaving aid and life-restoring hope. This integrated ministry response combined emergency relief with long-term development, strengthening both the physical resilience and social fabric of Israeli society.

In moments of devastation and in seasons of rebuilding, one message remained clear: Because of you, Israel was not alone.

You Stood with Israel in Her Darkest Hour

As Israel faced ongoing war and terror in 2025, your support enabled ICEJ AID to mobilize a rapid, sustained response for displaced families and frontline communities living under constant threat.

Emergency infrastructure projects included bomb shelters, ambulances, and communication systems protecting vulnerable regions. Trauma retreats brought emotional healing to terror survivors, while evacuee families received housing assistance, medical equipment, and financial relief.

Rebuilding extended into Gaza Envelope communities devastated by October 7—restoring youth centers, therapeutic facilities, and elderly care spaces, helping communities move from survival toward renewal.

You Cared for Holocaust Survivors

At the Haifa Home for Holocaust Survivors, residents received medical care, ate nutritious meals, and enjoyed activities that restored joy and dignity. Outings, art therapy, and holiday celebrations fostered community, while outreach teams delivered food parcels and personal visits to Survivors living alone.

In 2009, ICEJ began a partnership with the local charity to provide a home especially for lonely survivors in the current crisis.

You Helped Bring the Jewish People Home

In 2025, ICEJ AID funded **726 Aliyah flights**, assisting **more than 3,000 Jewish immigrants** as they returned to their ancestral homeland. These new arrivals came from countries including **France, the United Kingdom, Ethiopia, and the former Soviet republics**, often motivated by rising antisemitism and a renewed desire to build their future in Israel.

Support extended far beyond travel. Through programs such as **First Home in the Homeland**, immigrant families received temporary housing, Hebrew language instruction, and guidance for navigating life in Israel during their first year. ICEJ also supported **youth preparation programs and professional retraining**, helping new immigrants adapt and thrive.

Behind every statistic are families courageously rebuilding their lives and contributing their gifts to Israel's future.

Since our founding in September 1980, the International Christian Embassy Jerusalem has assisted more than 170,000 Jews to make Aliyah to Israel.

You Helped Rebuild Lives and Restore Hope

Your generosity brought dignity, opportunity, and healing to vulnerable communities across Israel. From small business grants and workforce training for young mothers to high-tech education programs for minority students, these projects are opening doors to brighter futures and long-term independence.

At the same time, you continued to help communities devastated by the October 7 attacks rebuild and recover. Your support helped provide bomb shelters that double as trauma-therapy spaces, practical assistance for 52 displaced families from Kibbutz Nir Oz, and innovative initiatives like an agro-tech training greenhouse in southern Israel, preparing the next generation to restore farms damaged by war. And these are just a sample of the many ways you are helping Israelis heal, rebuild their communities, and look to the future with renewed hoped!

COMFORTING THE NATION OF ISRAEL

ICEJ AID, the Embassy's social assistance arm, touches the lives of all people in Israel by contributing to projects across the nation in every sector of society.

The Impact of Showing Up

In 2025, ICEJ USA tours to Israel became more than journeys—they became ministry in motion. At a time when Israel faced war, trauma, and global isolation, Christians showed up physically to stand in the gap.

From pastors and leaders at our Envision conference to volunteers on hands-on service tours, participants stepped into places still marked by the aftermath of October 7—*kibbutzim*, farms, schools, and survivor communities. They packed food, harvested crops, rebuilt homes, and cared for the vulnerable, bringing both practical aid and emotional encouragement.

Equally impactful were the personal encounters—listening to grieving families, praying with Holocaust Survivors, and worshipping alongside Israeli believers. Many described these moments as life-altering, deepening their faith while strengthening Israel's spirit.

Throughout the year, 87 American Christians participated in ICEJ USA tours and an additional

168 traveled to Israel for the Feast of Tabernacles, reminding Israelis that they are not alone.

Feast of Tabernacles 2025

In 2025, the Feast of Tabernacles became the largest Christian solidarity gathering in Israel during wartime—uniting believers in a visible stand with the Jewish people. More than 1,500 participants from over 70 nations came to worship, pray, and demonstrate unwavering support.

The United States was strongly represented, with **206 Americans** present in Jerusalem. The week featured worship gatherings, Israeli Guest Night, and the Roll Call of the Nations—culminating in the Jerusalem March, where **approximately 2,000 Christians** filled the streets in a powerful public expression of global friendship.

Impacting Government: Uniting Voices for Israel

ICEJ USA's advocacy efforts reached new levels of influence in 2025—mobilizing Christian leaders, strengthening Jewish-Christian partnerships, and ensuring Israel's concerns were heard at the highest levels of government.

More than **300 pastors, rabbis, and faith leaders from 29 states** gathered in Washington, DC, for Israel Advocacy Day, holding over **100 meetings** with senators and congressional members and staff to reinforce bipartisan, faith-based support for the US–Israel relationship.

Additional Capitol Hill engagement included participation in Israel Allies Foundation events, convening parliamentarians from **40 nations**.

Grassroots advocacy also surged. ICEJ USA delivered the **“No Bombs for Iran” petition representing 55,599 Americans** to national leaders, amplifying Christian concern over Iran's nuclear threat.

Meanwhile, the launch of the **Christian Declaration Against Antisemitism during Hanukkah** is

uniting believers across denominations in a formal stand against rising hatred.

Strategic alliances expanded through high-level meetings between Christian and Israeli leaders in Washington, DC, laying the groundwork for the 2026 launch of the Judeo-Christian Zionist Congress to confront global antisemitism and defend shared values.

At the same time, the American Christian Leaders for Israel (ACLI) network marked a decade of growth—now representing **3,000+ leaders** and tens of millions of Christians nationwide. In August, ACLI expanded its reach through Partner Networks. This coalition forms a powerful media and advocacy engine, shaping the national conversation, launching joint campaigns, and reaching tens of millions of Americans through television, radio, print, and digital platforms. Through briefings, petitions, congressional meetings, and global coalitions, ICEJ USA ensured that Christian support for Israel was not only visible but also measurable, organized, and impactful.

Impacting Media

Your support ensured Israel's story reached millions through ICEJ USA's expanding media platforms in 2025.

The *Out of Zion* podcast expanded globally through new distribution on Pray.com and Salem Media platforms. Digital engagement surged as believers interacted with teaching and advocacy content across

web and social channels. ACLI also partnered with digital media leaders to equip members—free of charge—with social media assets to speak truth online and counter misinformation. Together, these efforts amplified Christian perspectives on Israel across influential media outlets at a critical time.

Impacting the Church

In 2025, your support helped equip pastors, Christian leaders, and believers across the United States with biblical understanding, spiritual confidence, and practical resources to stand boldly with Israel.

Through regional Pastors & Leaders Gatherings, church partnerships, and national conference engagement, ICEJ USA created spaces for education, dialogue, and spiritual alignment around God's heart for Israel. Many leaders shared that navigating Israel-related topics had become increasingly complex in today's cultural climate. Yet through teaching rooted in Scripture, hearts were encouraged, unity deepened, and leaders left strengthened to guide their congregations with clarity and conviction.

Church events—from pastors' luncheons to Passover seders—helped believers reconnect

with the Hebraic roots of their faith, while outreach speaking engagements expanded national awareness and advocacy.

ICEJ USA also engaged leaders across major denominational gatherings, including the Pentecostal Charismatic Churches of North America Conference, Foursquare Connection Conference, Southern Baptist Convention, and Open Bible National Convention.

Embassy Publishers

Through Embassy Publishers, new books and devotionals helped readers explore the Hebrew roots of Scripture, confront antisemitism, and understand God's ongoing covenant purposes. ICEJ U further disciplined believers through online courses, video teaching, and study resources designed for both personal growth and church leadership.

In addition, ICEJ's expanding blog platform delivered timely biblical teaching, geopolitical insight, and firsthand ministry reports, helping Christians interpret current events through a scriptural lens.

Impacting the Next Generation

ICEJ USA made strategic investments in the next generation in 2025—equipping young adults, emerging influencers, and students to become informed, courageous advocates for Israel and the Jewish people.

At the Feast of Tabernacles, 19 young professionals experienced Israel firsthand—many for the first time—encountering the land of the Bible while witnessing the aftermath of October 7. Visits to sites like Kibbutz Be’eri and the Nova festival grounds deeply shaped their understanding and commitment to stand with Israel.

In November, more than 275 emerging Christian leaders (ages 20–45) gathered in Orlando for the Christian Leaders Summit, where pastors, media

voices, campus leaders, and influencers were equipped to confront antisemitism and communicate Israel’s biblical significance with clarity and confidence.

Our educational influence continued expanding within Christian higher education in 2025. Building on the 2024 launch of Regent University’s Institute for Israel Studies and ongoing partnership with South Florida Bible College, this year we helped Wheaton College establish an annual Feast of Tabernacles celebration for its students. Looking ahead, this growing academic footprint will extend even further as we help establish an Israel Center at Liberty University in 2026.

ICEJ USA also engaged students at the high school level—partnering with Christian educators to teach the Jewish roots of the faith and inspire biblical solidarity with Israel through creative, educational programming.

Through immersive travel, leadership training, and education, ICEJ USA is not only shaping today’s voices but preparing tomorrow’s defenders of Israel.

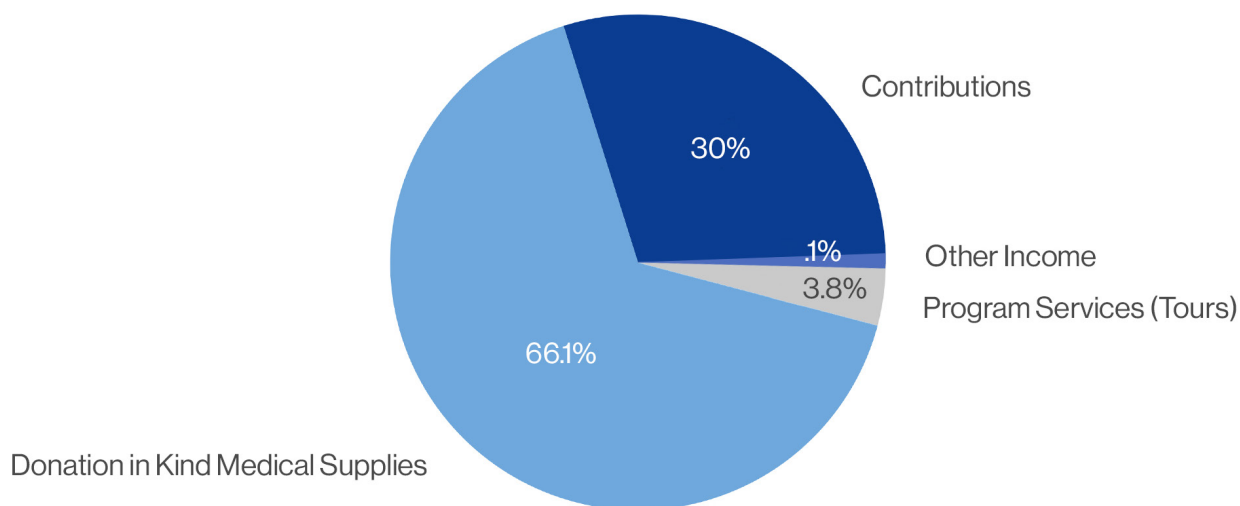

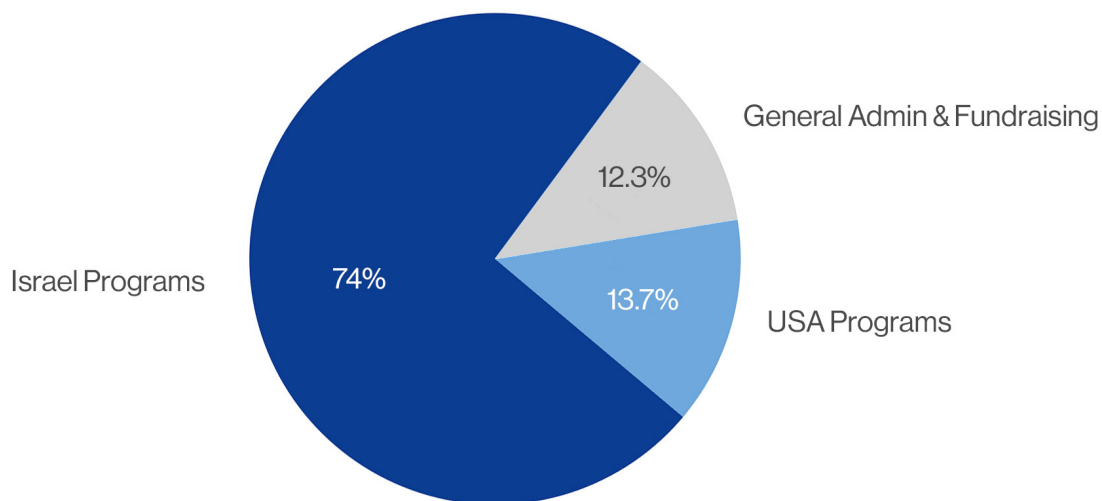

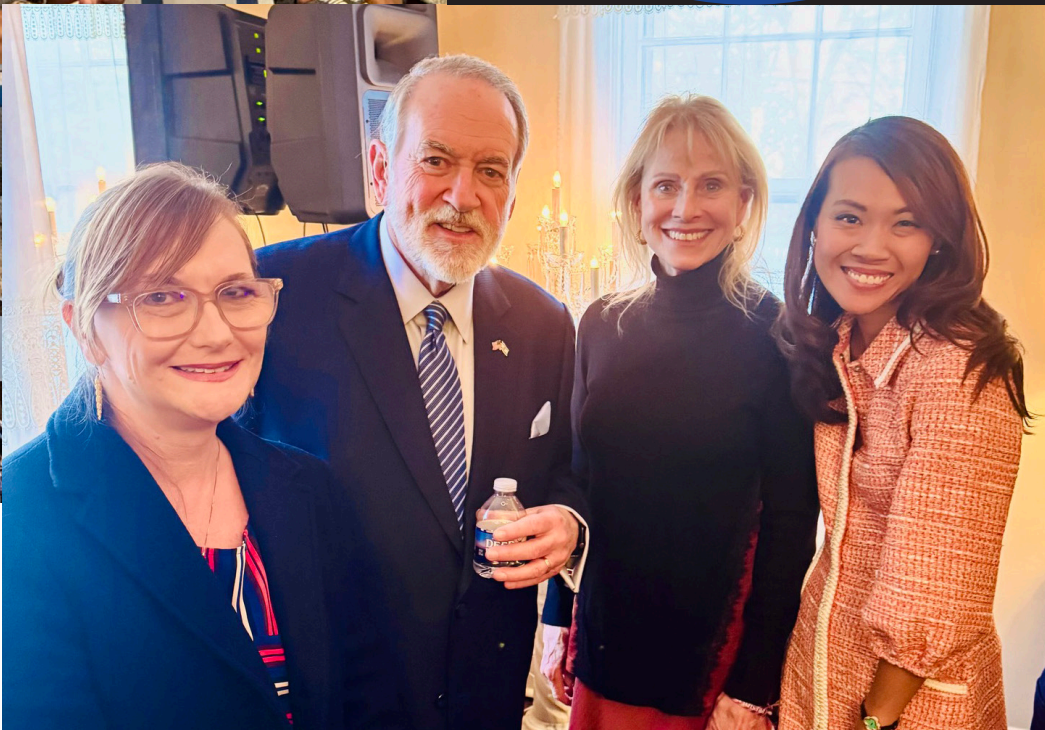
